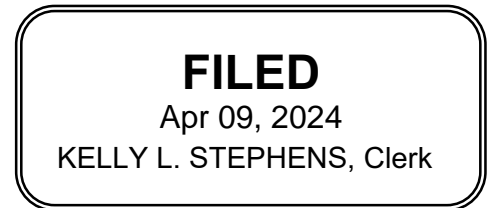

JUDGMENT

On Appeal from the United States District Court
for the Northern District of Ohio at Youngstown.

THIS CAUSE was heard on the record from the district court and was submitted on the briefs without oral argument.

IN CONSIDERATION THEREOF, it is ORDERED that the district court's order denying the motion for a three-judge court is REVERSED, its grant of the motions to dismiss and denial of the motion for a temporary restraining order and for class certification are VACATED, and the case is REMANDED to the district court with directions for it immediately to initiate the procedures to convene a three-judge court under 28 U.S.C. § 2284.
