Our office has received information that appears to indicate that your voter information matches with an individual who may not have been a United States citizen at the time of obtaining a Tennessee driver license or ID card.

Under Tennessee Code Annotated § 2-19-107, it is illegal for an individual who is not a citizen of the United States to vote in a local, state, or federal election in Tennessee.

Illegal voting is a felony. The potential penalty is at least 2 years in jail and a fine of up to \$5,000. We need to ensure Tennessee's voter rolls are correct.

If you need to correct your record, please follow these instructions.

For a person who is NOT a U. S. citizen:

If you are not a United States citizen and would like your name removed from the voter rolls at this time, you may use the enclosed form to make the request.

For a person who is a U. S. citizen with evidence of U. S. citizenship:

If you are a United States citizen and would like to submit proof of citizenship, you can submit a legible photocopy of one of the following documents:

- Birth certificate;
- United States passport, identifying the voter's name and showing the passport number;
- United States naturalization documentation, or the number of the voter's certificate of naturalization; or
- A document or method of proof of citizenship established by the federal Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986, P.L 99-603.
