**** TEXT ONLY ORDER ****

The court held a preliminary injunction hearing at which it also heard oral argument on a motion to dismiss filed by the Town of Thornapple defendants, Dkt. [13]. For reasons stated at the hearing, the motion to dismiss, Dkt. [13], is DENIED; the United States' motion for a preliminary injunction against the Thornapple defendants, Dkt. [3], is GRANTED; and the joint motion by the United States and the Town of Lawrence defendants for entry of a partial consent judgment and order, Dkt. [2], is GRANTED. The United States and the Thornapple defendants have until the close of business on October 1, 2024, to submit to the court a proposed injunction; if they cannot agree to the terms, then the parties shall clearly and briefly identify their disagreements. This shall be a joint submission. The parties should also advise the court as to what they think should happen next to resolve this case in its entirety.
