Statement of Issues on Appeal

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 30(b), Defendant-Appellant states that the issues on appeal include whether Plaintiffs and Plaintiff-Intervenors lack standing; whether Plaintiffs' claims are ripe; whether Intervenor-Plaintiffs' claim regarding Act 602 of 2025 is moot; and whether the district court erred in preliminarily enjoining Defendant from: (1) disclosing information provided by Plaintiffs or Intervenor-Plaintiffs under Ark. Code Ann. § 7-9-601; (2) enforcing Act 602 of 2025 against Intervenor-Plaintiffs on the ground that it violates the First Amendment; (3) enforcing Acts 241 and 453 of 2025 against Plaintiffs on the grounds that they violate the First Amendment; and (4) enforcing Acts 218, 240, and 274 of 2025

against Plaintiffs or Intervenor-Plaintiffs on the grounds that they likely violate the First Amendment.
