Pending a decision on the request for a stay pending appeal, the district court's October 9, 2025, order is temporarily **STAYED** only to the extent it enjoined the federalization of the National Guard of the United States within Illinois. Members of the National Guard do not need to return to their home states unless further ordered by a court to do so.
