As set forth in Defendants' accompanying Memorandum in Support, Plaintiffs' claims in each matter should be dismissed for lack of subject matter jurisdiction pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(1), or alternatively, for failure to state a

claim upon which relief may be granted pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(6).
