On September 25, 2025, the Court heard Plaintiffs’ Motion for Temporary Injunction. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Court took the motion under advisement until the parties filed additional briefing regarding *In re Khanoyan*, 637 S.W.3d 762 (Tex. 2022). After considering the motion, responsive briefing, arguments of counsel, evidence presented at the Temporary Injunction hearing, and relevant legal authority, the Court determines that Plaintiffs’ Motion for Temporary Injunction should be denied for the reasons set forth in Defendants’ Response to Motion for Temporary Injunction and Reply

Regarding *Khanoyan* and the Brief of the State of Texas in Opposition to Plaintiffs' Motion for Temporary and Permanent Injunction.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Plaintiffs' Motion for Temporary Injunction is denied.
