Motion to Withdraw

Consistent with the State Election Commission Defendants' (SEC) response to the Court's Text Order, Dkt. No. 53, the SEC respectfully requests that the Court allow the SEC to withdraw its Motion to Dismiss, Dkt. No. 15, which was filed January 20, 2026, as the SEC believes that the Court's adjudication of the SEC's pending Motion for Summary Judgment, Dkt No. 38, renders the SEC's Motion to Dismiss moot. The arguments outlined in the SEC's Motion to Dismiss and Memorandum in Support are fully incorporated in the SEC's subsequently filed Motion for Summary Judgment and Memorandum in Support. As further agreed in the SEC's response to Dkt. No. 53, the SEC believes it is appropriate to withdraw its Motion to Dismiss for the sake of judicial efficiency.
