**INTERVENER STATES' MOTION TO TRANSFER**

On March 31, 2026, President Donald J. Trump issued an Executive Order entitled “Ensuring Citizenship Verification and Integrity in Federal Elections.” *See* Exec. Order 14,399, 91 Fed. Reg. 17125 (Mar. 31, 2026). Plaintiffs in this action represent various non-profit, not-for-profit, non-partisan, and community-based political and civic groups (“Plaintiffs”) who challenge the Executive Order. Three cases that challenge the same Executive Order are already pending in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia. Because of their commonalities, the D.D.C. cases were consolidated.

The Intervener States respectfully move this Court to transfer this case to the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

In support of this Motion, the Intervener States respectfully refer the Court to their Memorandum of Law, filed herewith.
