NOTICE

Federal Defendants in the above-captioned matters respectfully submit the following notice regarding recent developments in this matter:

On June 18, 2026, pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552a(r), the Postal Service provided advance notice of a proposed new General Privacy Act System of Records (“SORN”) to coincide with its proposal to amend the *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM), regarding the transmission of mail-in or absentee ballots for federal elections. *See* ECF No. 152.

Earlier today, that SORN was made available for public inspection ahead of formal publication at: [federalregister.gov/public-inspection/2026-14508/privacy-act-systems-of-records](https://www.federalregister.gov/public-inspection/2026-14508/privacy-act-systems-of-records). Formal publication is scheduled to occur on July 17, 2027. In addition to stating that the System of Record will not take effect until a final rule amending the DMM is published, the SORN expressly acknowledges that the proposed rule is the subject of active litigation and provides that a final rule will not be published unless and until the government obtains relief from all relevant injunctions.
