RE: Voter List Request

Dear Ms. Dhillon,

I am confirming our receipt of your September 8, 2025, letter requesting a copy of Idaho's voter registration list. Idaho is committed to performing regular maintenance of its voter registration rolls to ensure they remain current and accurate. This includes regular coordination and data comparison with our local partners at the Idaho Division of Motor Vehicles, Idaho Department of Corrections, and Idaho Vital Statistics to ensure only eligible voters remain on our rolls.

Last year, Idaho Governor Brad Little signed an executive order, The Only Citizens Can Vote Act, which led to an enhanced voter list maintenance partnership with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) through the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS). These efforts have led to a collaborative effort to help improve the functionality of the Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Program. Our use of the SAVE database has allowed Idaho to confirm citizenship for Idaho voters and led to the identification of potential non-citizens who have been removed from our rolls and been referred to the U.S. Attorney's Office for prosecution of federal voting crimes.

As you and your team pursue efforts to ensure voter list maintenance occurs in each state, I encourage you to coordinate and work with officials at USCIS. They are currently leading some of the most significant efforts to develop and improve tools to aid states in ensuring only eligible voters are on our voter rolls.

Per your request, I have instructed my staff to upload a copy of Idaho's voter registration list to the JEFS file-sharing system. After consulting with the Idaho Attorney General's Office, we will be sharing a copy of our publicly available file, which does not contain any personally identifiable information. We welcome a dialogue with your office to continue to discuss the broader efforts to ensure the accuracy of Idaho's voter rolls.
